Checklist – 25 pts	All items are included and are blended into the final project well. They look like they belong. (23-25 pts)	Missing 3-5 items and/or 3-5 items are not blended well. This means that even if you have all of the items, but some are just randomly dropped onto the picture, you will be marked down. (20-22 pts)	Missing 6-9 items or 69 items are not blended well. This means that even if you have all of the items, but they are just randomly dropped onto the picture, you will be marked down. (17-19 pts)	Missing 10 or more items or 10 or more items are included but not blended into the picture. (15-16 pts)	No effort made to put correct graphics/pictures into project. This means items are not blended or checklist was ignored. (0-14 pts)
Software – 50 pts	Final project demonstrates proficiency of layers, blending, and other adobe software tools as practiced in class. Resembles a Where's Waldo Picture – items are a part of the picture, not randomly placed. (45-50 pts)	Final project demonstrates understanding of layers, blending, and other adobe software tools but could be more professional. Scene and images do not match, software tools not used with precision. (40-44 pts)	Final project demonstrates knowledge of software tools, but lacks mastery of the skills. Needs more practice to be considered proficient. Disconnect between scene and items placed. Adobe skills lack attention to detail. (35-39 pts)	Final project does not demonstrate understanding of software. Items are not blended, layered or mastered. Adobe skills are not evident. Copy and paste look is present. (30-34 pts)	Does not understand how to use adobe software. Most of project is copied and pasted. (0-29 pts)
Final Product – 25 pts	Project, answer key, & AI file are submitted and complete. (23-25 pts)	Project, answer key, & AI file are submitted but 1 is unfinished. (20-22 pts)	Project, answer key, & AI file are submitted but none are complete. (17-19 pts)	Only one product is turned in. (15-16 pts)	Only one or none of the final products are turned in. (0-14 pts)
